

Perl Script Fix for Pulse Sequence Syntax

A Perl script to fix non-standard syntaxes in pulse sequences and a corresponding batch mode executable are available. The script name is `fixlek` and the executable is `fixlek_c.com`. One should keep the file `fixlek` in `/home/userdir`. Collect all the sequences that need to be fixed in a separate directory and place the `fixlek_c.com` file in that directory and run it. All the sequence source code will be checked and the fixed version will be put in a new directory called `psglib_fixed`.
